

## **2013 Delta Region SCCA Solo Championship Series**

There are three distinct series in the Solo Champion Series: The Class Championship, The PAX Championship, and the Driver of the Year. All 2013 Delta Solo Events count towards these series.

### **Solo Class Championship**

Open to SCCA Members and competing in Delta Region Events during 2013, this series awards a single Class Championship Series Award to the driver with the most points in their class.

Solo Class Championship Series Points:

1st place = 12 points

2nd place = 9 points

3rd place = 7 points

4th place = 5 points

5th place = 4 points

6th place = 3 points

7th place = 2 points

All other places = 1 point

DNS or DQS = 0 points

### **Solo Class Championship Series Rules**

1. The Region Points keeper will track and post results after each event.
2. Compete in 60.1% of all Delta-sanctioned Solo events during 2013. Example: Delta has 10 points events scheduled in 2013, a driver will need to attend 7 or more of those events to be eligible for a Solo Class Championship.
3. Points are awarded by Class finish. A driver may win a Class Championship in only one Class. Points earned in other Classes will be recorded but are not transferable to the driver's main competing class.
4. Novice drivers are scored into their normal Class. There is no Novice Class Championship.
5. Any driver, regardless of region is eligible, Weekend Members are not eligible to score points in the Class Championship.
6. X-Class will be run at all Delta events for drivers who wish to compete outside of the normal event and class structure. X-Class is run for time-only, and carries a PAX index of 1.000. X-Class is **not** eligible for a Class Championship Series trophy.

### **Solo PAX Championship**

Open to all SCCA Members in Delta Region Events during 2013, this series awards a single PAX Championship Series Award to the driver with the most points in this PAX-based scoring system.

## **PAX Championship Series Points**

Points for the PAX Championship series are awarded by a percentile system. All points are computed as a percentage of the top PAX time, multiplied by 10,000. The top PAX driver gets 10,000 points. The formula for points is  $10,000 \times (\text{DriverIndexTime} / \text{TopIndexTime})$ , where DriverIndexTime is the PAX time for that driver, and TopIndexTime is the PAX time for the top PAX driver at that event.

## **PAX Championship Series Rules**

1. The Region Pointskeeper will track and post results after each event.
2. Attend 60.1% of all Delta-sanctioned Solo events during 2011. Example: Delta has 10 points events scheduled in 2013, a driver will need to attend 7 or more of those events to be eligible for a Solo Class Championship. Novice drivers are scored into their normal Class. There is no Novice PAX Championship.
3. Any driver, regardless of region is eligible, Weekend Members are not eligible to score points in the Class Championship.
4. X-Class will be run at all Delta events for drivers who wish to compete outside of the normal event and class structure. X-Class is run for time-only, and carries a PAX index of 1.000. X-Class is **not** eligible for a PAX Championship Series trophy.
5. Drop events: 2/3 of Delta events will count. Based on a 10 event 2013 schedule, the best 7 PAX scores for a driver will count.

## **Driver of the Year Award**

The Driver of the Year award shall be awarded to the Delta driver that accumulated the most points, according to the following rules.

### Driver of the Year Series Points:

- 1st place = 12 points
- 2nd place = 9 points
- 3rd place = 7 points
- 4th place = 5 points
- 5th place = 4 points
- 6th place = 3 points
- 7th place = 2 points
- All other places = 1 point
- DNS or DQS = 0 points

### Additional points will be assigned as follows:

- +25 points for attending the SCCA National Championship
- +15 points for attending an SCCA National Tour or Divisional
- +10 points for attending TLAC
- +10 points for Top PAX
- +10 points for FTD
- +5 points for attending a outside regional event (CENLA, Gulf Coast, etc.)

### Driver of the Year Series Points:

1. Only Delta Members are eligible.
2. The driver receives points for all sanctioned SCCA Solo events in which they compete. A DNS or DSQ receives no points.
3. For points earned at events other than Delta events, the driver must submit the official event results to the Assistant Regional Executive prior to December 31 of that same year. Results may be verified against published online results.
4. The Standard 12-9-7-5-4-3-2-1 points assignment (see Class Championship) will be used.
5. Drivers may compete in multiple classes throughout the year.
